The Essex County Council (Essex Country Parks) (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 202*

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Essex County Council in exercise of its powers under Section 32, 35 and 38 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the 1984 Act”), and the Traffic Management Act 2004 (“the 2004 Act”) and all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Parts 1 to III of Schedule 9 of the 1984 Act, propose to make the above Order.

The effect of the Order will introduce a new Essex Country Parks Off-Street Parking Places Order setting out the terms and conditions for the use of the Essex Country Park Car Parking areas as listed and shown in schedule 1 of the Order. These parking areas are located within Cudmore, Danbury, Great Notley, Hadleigh, Thorndon North, Thorndon South and Weald, Essex County Council Country Parks. The Order will also enable the Council to enforce non-compliant use of the car park using the legislation of the Traffic Management Act 2004 and includes the provision to accommodate and manage designated spaces for electric vehicle charging points for potential future use. The fees for parking will remain as currently set.
