

**The Essex County Council (West Stockwell Street, East Stockwell Street,
Maidenburgh Street and George Street, Colchester) (Prohibition of Motor
Vehicles) Order 202***

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as “the Council”), in exercise of its powers under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2) and 4 and Part IV of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as “the Act”), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. Save as provided in Article 2 no person shall cause or permit any vehicle travelling to proceed in the roads identified in column 1 of the schedule to this order at the location identified in column 2 of the schedule.
2. Nothing in Article 1 of this order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in the roads identified in the schedule if the vehicle is being used for fire and rescue, police, or ambulance purposes.
3. The Essex County Council (West Stockwell Street, East Stockwell Street, Maidenburgh Street and George Street, Colchester) (No Entry & Revocation of One Way) Order 2022 is hereby revoked.
4. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
5. This Order shall come into operation on the Day of 202* and may be cited as the The Essex County Council (West Stockwell Street, East Stockwell Street, Maidenburgh Street and George Street, Colchester) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 202*

Road	Location
West Stockwell Street	At a point approximately 13 metres north of its junction with High Street (Implemented by Bollards)
East Stockwell Street	At a point approximately 9 metres north its junction with High Street (Implemented by Bollards)
Maidenburgh Street	At a point approximately 7 metres north its junction with High Street (Implemented by Bollards)
George Street	Between a point approximately 60 metres north of its junction with High Street and a point 15 metres north of that point (Implemented by Bollards)
