Proposed Implementation of a (Zebra) Pedestrian Crossing on Broomstick Hall Road, Waltham Abbey, Epping Forest

## The Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.55) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given that** the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

### Effect of the Order:

#### 1. To Revoke: 'Red Route - No Stopping Mon-Fri 8:15am-9:15am 2:30pm-3:30pm Restrictions'

Road	Description
Broomstick Hall Road	<b>North Side:</b> From a point approximately 4 metres east of the rear property wall of No.14 Brookside east for approximately 40 metres. <b>South Side:</b> From a point approximately 1 metre east of the rear property wall of No.14 Brookside, east for approximately 29 metres.

#### 2. To Implement: Red Route – 'No Stopping at Any Time Restrictions'

Road	Description
Broomstick Hall Road	<b>South Side:</b> From a point approximately 1 metre east of the rear property wall of 14 Brookside, west for approximately 37 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into the 'Essex County Council (Epping Forest District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by substituting map tiles: TL390 007 Revision 5 to Revision 6 and TL395 007 Revision 4 to Revision 5.

**Notice is also hereby given** that under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the Essex County Council proposes **To Implement:** a Zebra Crossing on the following length of Broomstick Hall Road

Location of the crossing centre line	From a point approximately 18 metres east of the boundary of 129 Broomstick Hall Road and rear of 14 Brookside
Width between Stop lines	Approximately 5 metres between stop lines
Length of zigzags	Approximately 17.5 metres either side of the crossing.
