

North The Essex County Council (Wick Road, Boxted - Bridge No. 0059) Prohibition of Motorised Vehicles (and Restriction of Other Traffic) Order 202*

The Essex County Council in exercise of its powers under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) as amended and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. In this Order

“motor vehicle” shall have the same meaning as given in Section 136 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

"motorcycle" means a mechanically propelled vehicle not being an invalid carriage with less than four wheels and the weight of which unladen does not exceed 410 kilograms, as defined in Section 136(4) of the Act of 1984.

2. The Essex County Council Shall Prohibit the following to access or to proceed on Wick Road, (Carrying Bridge No. 0059), in the Parish of Boxted in the City of Colchester, (also in the Parish of Stoke-By-Nayland, Suffolk) from its Junction with Lower Farm Road and Sky Hall Hill northeast for approximately 15 metres
- a) Motor Vehicles
 - b) Motorcycles
 - c) Horse Drawn Vehicles
 - d) Ridden or Led Horse/s
 - e) Livestock
3. This Order shall come into operation on XXXXXXXX and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Wick Road, Boxted - Bridge No. 0059) Prohibition of Motorised Vehicles (and Restriction of Other Traffic) Order 202*
4. The Council is satisfied that for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the order relates or any other road and for preventing damage to the road or buildings on or near it, it is requisite that Section 3(1) of the 1984 Act should not apply in relation to this Order.
5. The restrictions imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation from any restriction or requirement imposed by any other enactment.
