

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Dovercourt, District of Tendring) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 202*.

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 (1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) (hereinafter referred to as "The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 30 miles per hour on the lengths of road in the Tendring District, as specified in the schedule below.
2. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order shall come into operation on ** ***** 202* and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Dovercourt, District of Tendring) (30mph Speed Limit) Order 202*.

SCHEDULE:

1. To Implement: 30mph Speed Limit Restrictions.

Road	Description
Station Lane	From a point approximately 132 metres west of its junction with Kingsway, West for approximately 216 metres to its junction with Pattrick's Lane.
Pattrick's Lane	From a point approximately 64 metres northwest of its junction with High Street, Northwest for approximately 118 metres to its junction with Station Lane.
