

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.37) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the Order:

To Implement: 'No Stopping at Any Time' (Red Route) Restrictions in the District of Uttlesford

Road	Description
Frambury Lane	West Side: From a point approximately 3 metres from the extended southern kerb line of the Newport Primary School entrance southwest for approximately 83.5 metres. East Side: (i) From a point approximately 3 metres from the extended southern kerb line of the Newport Primary School entrance southwest for approximately 64 metres. (ii) From the extended southern kerb line of the School Car Park Entrance south for approximately 18.5 metres.
Car Park Entrance	From its junction with Frambury Lane east for approximately 4.5 metres

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting map tile/s: TL515 335 Revision 0 to Revision 1 and Introducing TL515 332
