

The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.37) Order 202*.

Statement of Reasons

The location – Frambury Lane, is a rural residential road that houses Newport Primary School at the southern end of the lane. The end of the lane is the start of a bridleway which is much narrower than Frambury Lane, which leads to the recreation ground and youth centre, which is popular and in regular use by local residents and visitors.

The County Council will introduce a No Stopping At Any Time restriction (double red lines) just south of the entrance of the school. This restriction will prevent vehicles from parking along the described length of this narrow bridleway, and obstructing the footway.

This will maintain the safe movement of pedestrians, horses and vehicles and retain sight lines, by eliminating physical and visibility obstructions to users of the bridleway.

These proposals are being funded solely by a developer, with no associated costs to the Highway Authority.
