Proposed Upgrade of an existing Pedex Pedestrian Crossing to Conversion to a near sided Toucan LED Crossing on White Hart Lane, in the City of Chelmsford.

Notice is hereby given that under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the Essex County Council proposes to Implement the following Toucan Pedestrian Crossing, on White Hart Lane in the City of Chelmsford.

To Implement: a Conversion of the current Pedex Crossing to Conversion to a near sided Toucan LED Crossing on the following length of road

Location: White Hart Lane, West of Boleyn Gardens (Springfield & Chelmsford Garden parishes), in the City of Chelmsford

- (i) The **Centre line** of the crossing will be located approximately 52 metres south east of the junction New Nabbotts Roundabout
- (ii) The **width** of the crossing between stop 'give way' lines will be approximately 10 metres.
- (iii) **Crossing Zigzags**
 - Approximately 17.5 metres - to the north of the Crossing
 - Approximately 17.5 metres - to the south of the Crossing
