

**The Essex County Council (Various Roads, (North of Rayne Road)  
Braintree) (20mph Zone) Order 202\***

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on hour on the said lengths of road, in Braintree, in the District of Braintree, as specified in the schedule to this order.
2. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.

## Schedule

### To Implement a '20mph Zone'

Road	Description
Broomfield Way	From a point approximately 10 metres north of its junction with Rayne Road for its entire remaining length including private drives and any turning heads.
Osier Place	From its junction with Broomfield Way for its entire length including private drives and any turning heads.
Allan-Williams View	From its junction with Broomfield Way for its entire length including private drives.
Home Field Drive	From its junction with Broomfield Way for its entire length including private drives and any turning heads.
Badger Mount	From its junction with Broomfield Way for its entire length including private drives and any turning heads.
