

ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (A131 MOUNT HILL, HALSTEAD)
(RESTRICTED ROADS) ORDER 1995

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 82(2) and 83(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. The length of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become a restricted road for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act.
2. The County Council of Essex (40 mph Speed Limit) (No. 3) Order 1971 is hereby revoked.
3. This Order shall come into operation on 11 December 1995 and may be cited as the Essex County Council (A131 Mount Hill, Halstead (Restricted Roads) Order 1995.

SCHEDULE

Length of road at Halstead in the District of Braintree

- A131 Mount Hill, Halstead - from the terminal point of the existing 30 miles per hour limit, approximately 79 metres south of the junction with Trinity Road, generally south-westwards to a point approximately 122 metres south-west of its junction with White Horse Avenue, a total distance of approximately 590 metres.
