

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (High Street, South Benfleet) (Experimental One Way) Order 2019

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council has made the above Order under Sections 9 and 10 and Part III of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**Effect of the order:** To introduce on an experimental basis a one way restriction on the following length of High Street, South Benfleet in the Borough of Castle Point:

Road	Permitted Direction of Travel
High Street, South Benfleet - From a point parallel with the northern kerb line of Station Road, in a north westerly direction until its junction with the roundabout joining B1014 Ferry Road.	In a north westerly direction

**Date of operation:** The Order will come into operation on **1 February 2019** and is due to last for a maximum of 18 months.

**Further details:** A copy of the Order, a plan illustrating the proposal, a copy of this notice and a Statement of Reasons may be examined at all reasonable hours at Essex County Council, County Hall E block main reception, Market Road, Chelmsford; Castle Point Borough Council, Kiln Road, Thundersley and South Benfleet Library, 264 High Road, Benfleet. **Objections:** The Essex County Council will consider in due course whether the provisions of the experimental order should be continued in force indefinitely. Within a period of six months beginning from the date on which the experimental order came into force, or if that order is varied by another order or modified pursuant to Section 10(2) of the 1984 Act, beginning with the day on which the variation or modification or the latest variation or modification came into force, any person may object to the making of an order for the purpose of such indefinite continuation. Any such objections must be in writing, state the grounds on which it is made and be sent to TRO Comments, Network Assurance, A2 Annexe, Seax House, Victoria Road South, Chelmsford, Essex, CM1 1QH' or e-mail to [TrafficRegulation.Order@essexhighways.org](mailto:TrafficRegulation.Order@essexhighways.org) quoting reference TRAF/6894 by 1 August 2019. All comments will be welcome in order that the effectiveness of the scheme may be judged.
