

The Essex County Council (High Street, South Benfleet) (Experimental One Way) Order 2019

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III to Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order may be cited as the Essex County Council (High Street, South Benfleet) (Experimental One Way) Order 2019 and shall come into operation on 1 February 2019.
2. Save as provided in Article 3 no person shall except under the direction of a Police Constable in uniform cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of High Street, South Benfleet in the Borough of Castle Point specified in column 1 of the Schedule to this Order [hereinafter referred to as the said length of road] in a direction other than that specified in column 2 of the said Schedule.
3. Nothing in Article 2 of this Order shall apply so as to prevent any person from causing any vehicle to proceed in a direction other than that specified in column 2 of the Schedule to this Order on the said length of road if the vehicle is being used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance purposes.
4. The restriction imposed by this Order shall be in addition to and not in derogation of any restrictions or requirement imposed by any regulations made or having effect as if made under the Act or by or under any other enactment.
5. This Order shall have an effect for a period of not exceeding 18 months from the date specified in Article 1 hereof or until it is made permanent.
6. Pursuant to Section 10(2) of the Act, the Service Director, Development, Highways and Transportation may if it appears to him in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road affected by the Order runs, and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police, make modifications of any description (other than additions) to the Order or suspend the Order or any provision thereof.
