Proposed Conversion of Footway/Verge to Unsegregated Shared Footway/Cycleway – Army & Navy Roundabout (junction with Baddow Road) and Essex Yeomanry Way, Great Baddow

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to convert existing footway and verge to a shared unsegregated footway/cycleway at Army & Navy Roundabout (junction with Baddow Road) and Essex Yeomanry Way, Great Baddow in the City of Chelmsford under highway improvement powers given by Section 65 of the Highways Act 1980:

Shared unsegregated Footway/Cycleway – width varying between 2 metres and 4.5 metres

| Army & Navy Roundabout (junction with Baddow Road), Great Baddow | EAST SIDE: from the initial start line of the Army & Navy subway southern ramp, north east for a distance of approximately 35 metres to its junction with Essex Yeomanry Way existing southern side footway. |
| Essex Yeomanry Way, Great Baddow | SOUTH SIDE: From its junction with the Army & Navy roundabout eastern footway, east for a distance of approximately 40 metres. |
