

The Essex County Council (Harwich Road (east) and Harwich Road (west), Great Bromley/Little Bentley) (40mph & 50mph Speed Limit) Order 201*

The Essex County Council (“the Council”) in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (“the Act”) and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of Harwich Road (east), Great Bromley/Little Bentley in the District of Tendring, from a point approximately 13.3 metres north east of its junction with the A120/Harwich Road Roundabout, north east for a distance of approximately 137 metres.
2. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 50 miles per hour on that length of Harwich Road (west), Great Bromley/Little Bentley in the District of Tendring, from the centre of the circulatory carriageway of the A120/Harwich Road Roundabout, south west for a distance of approximately 38 metres.
3. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
4. This Order shall come into operation on ***** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Harwich Road (east) and Harwich Road (west), Great Bromley/Little Bentley) (40mph & 50mph Speed Limit) Order 201*.
