

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (Harwich Road (east) and Harwich Road (west), Great Bromley/Little Bentley) (40mph & 50mph Speed Limit) Order 201\*

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Part III to Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

### Effect of the order:

1. To introduce a 40mph speed limit on Harwich Road (east), Great Bromley/Little Bentley in the District of Tendring, from a point approximately 13.3 metres north east of its junction with the A120/Harwich Road Roundabout, north east for a distance of approximately 137 metres (The road is currently National Speed Limit).
2. To introduce a 50mph speed limit on Harwich Road (west), Great Bromley/Little Bentley in the District of Tendring, from the centre of the circulatory carriageway of the A120/Harwich Road Roundabout, south west for a distance of approximately 38 metres (The road is currently National Speed Limit).
