

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, District of Harlow) (Parking and Waiting) (Amendment No.16) Order 201*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part III & IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions on the following lengths of road in the District of Harlow:

Road	Description
Commonside, Harlow	NORTH SIDE: From a point approximately 10 metres east of the centre of its junction with Keaton Way to a point approximately 10 metres west of the centre of its junction with Keaton Way. Map tile: TL450 075 revision 1 to revision 2
Keaton Way, Harlow	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with Commonside Road in a generally north easterly direction for an approximate distance of 73 metres. Map tiles: TL450 075 and TL450 077 revision 1 to revision 2.
Mosaic Lane, Harlow	BOTH SIDES: <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. From its junction with Keaton Way, north east for a distance of approximately 10 metres.ii. From its junction with Eve Drive, south west for a distance of approximately 10 metres. Map tile: TL450 077 revision 1 to revision 2
Eve Drive, Harlow	SOUTH SIDE: From the eastern kerb line to the western kerb line, a distance of approximately 6 metres (this covers the dropped kerb entrance to residential properties and private parking area). WEST SIDE: <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. From a point approximately 9 metres south east of its junction with southern kerblines of Mosaic Lane (end of the road located at dropped kerb entrance to the residential properties and private parking area), north west for a distance of approximately 27 metres.ii. From a point approximately 22 metres north west of the northern extended kerb line of Mosaic Lane, north west for a distance of approximately 16 metres. EAST SIDE: <ul style="list-style-type: none">i. From a point approximately 9 metres south east of its junction with southern kerblines of Mosaic Lane (end of the road located at dropped kerb entrance to the residential properties and private parking area), north west for a distance of approximately 37 metres.ii. From a point approximately 27 metres north west of the northern extended kerb line of Mosaic Lane, north west for a distance of approximately 10 metres. Map tile: TL450 077 revision 1 to revision 2
Iceni Square, Harlow	SOUTH WEST SIDE: From a point approximately 39 metres north west of the northern extended kerb line of Mosaic Lane, south west for a distance of approximately 10 metres. EAST SIDE: From a point approximately 39 metres north west of the northern extended kerb line of Mosaic Lane, north west for a distance of approximately 5 metres. NORTH SIDE: From its junction with Iceni Square/Keaton Way, east for a distance of approximately 10 metres.



	SOUTH SIDE: From its junction with Icen Square/Keaton Way, east for a distance of approximately 7 metres. Map tile: TL450 077 revision 1 to revision 2
Iceni Square/Keaton Way, Harlow	BOTH SIDES: From the southern extended kerb line of Icen Square (side road), generally north west for a distance of approximately 39 metres. Map tile: TL450 077 revision 1 to revision 2

This Order will be incorporated into The District of Harlow (On Street) (Waiting, Loading and Parking) (Consolidation) Order 2011 by substituting tile numbers TL450 075 and TL450 077 revision 1 to revision 2.
