

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Hempstead) (30MPH & 40MPH Speed Limit) Order 201*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To introduce a 40MPH speed limit on the following length of B1054, Hempstead in the District of Uttlesford (the road is currently national speed limit):

Road	Description
B1054, Hempstead	From a point approximately 75 metres north-east of the north-eastern kerb line of Boyton's Lane, in a south-westerly direction for a distance of approximately 245 metres.

'The Essex County Council (Hempstead) (Restricted Road) Order 2008' is hereby revoked. The restrictions contained within this order shall continue in force by virtue of this new order.
