

**THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (HEMPSTEAD) (RESTRICTED ROAD)
ORDER 2008**

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 82 (2); 83 (2); 84(1) and (2); and Part IV to Schedule 9 to the Act, of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III to Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. The lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this Order shall become restricted roads for the purpose of Section 81 of the Act.
2. This Order may be cited as The Essex County Council (Hempstead) (Restricted Road) Order 2008 and shall become operational on 27 October 2008.
3. This Order revokes the Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Restricted Road) Order 2006, in so far as it relates to Hempstead only. The restrictions within that Order, not relating to Hempstead, shall continue in force.

| The Radwinter/Wixoe Road (B1054) | (Hill Road and High Street) From a point 195 metres west of its junction with Anser Road (B1055) eastwards and then north-eastwards to a point 49 metres northeast of its junction with Coach Road, a total distance of approximately 1101 metres. |
