

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (Castle Point Borough) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Amendment No.44) Order 201\*

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part III & IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**Effect of the order:** To introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions on 1) Matlock Road, Canvey Island in the Borough of Castle Point: BOTH SIDES: from its junction with Hertford Road, north for approximately 15 metres. 2) Hertford Road, Canvey Island in the Borough of Castle Point: NORTH SIDE: From its junction with Matlock Road in westerly direction for approximately 12 metres and in an easterly direction for approximately 15 metres.

The Essex County Council (Castle Point Borough) (Permitted Parking Area and Special Parking Area) (Consolidation) Order 2008 will be varied by substituting tile number TQ785 830 revision 2 to revision 3.
