


The Essex County Council (B183 (to become the A1025) Gilden Way/Sheering Road, Harlow/Sheering) (40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2019

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Part IV of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby makes the following Order: -

1. No person shall cause any motor vehicle to proceed at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour on that length of B183 (to become the A1025) Gilden Way/Sheering Road, Harlow/Sheering in the District of Harlow and Epping Forest, from the central island east of London Road Roundabout in a generally north easterly direction for an approximate distance of 2370 metres (1.48 miles) including a section of new carriageway up to the new roundabout that is going to be built and known as The Champions [hereinafter referred to as the said length of road].
2. No speed limit imposed by this order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3 (5) of those regulations.
3. The derestriction order on B183 (to become the A1025) Gilden Way/Sheering Road, Harlow/Sheering in the District of Harlow and Epping Forest will be revoked insofar as it relates to the said length of road.
4. This Order shall come into operation on 1 November 2019 and may be cited as The Essex County Council (B183 (to become the A1025) Gilden Way/Sheering Road, Harlow/Sheering) (40MPH Speed Limit) Order 2019.
