

Public notice

The Essex County Council (City of Chelmsford) (Waiting, Loading and Parking Consolidation) (Variation No.100) Order 201*

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Orders: 1) To introduce 'No Waiting at Any Time' restrictions on the following roads in the City of Chelmsford:

LOCATION	EXTENT
Coval Lane	EAST SIDE: From its junction with Hardy Close in a northerly direction for approximately 10 metres and in a southerly direction for approximately 10 metres (This will replace the existing Permit Parking Mon-Fri 8am-6pm restrictions)
Hardy Close (northern section)	BOTH SIDES: i. from its junction with Coval Lane in a south-easterly direction for a distance of approximately 10 metres. ii. from approximately 80 metres south east from its junction with Coval Lane extending first in a south-easterly direction and then in a northerly direction for a distance of approximately 42 metres to the end of the road.
Hardy Close (southern section)	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with Hardy Close (northern section), south for a distance of approximately 10 metres.

2) To introduce permit parking Mon-Fri 8am-6pm Zone 1 to the following lengths of Hardy Close in the City of Chelmsford:

LOCATION	EXTENT
Hardy Close (northern section)	BOTH SIDES: From a point approximately 10 metres south east of its junction with Coval Lane, south east for a distance of approximately 70 metres.
Hardy Close (southern section)	BOTH SIDES: From a point 10 metres south of its junction with Hardy Close (northern section), south for its remaining length including all turning heads.

All residential properties of Hardy Close will be eligible to apply for a permit.

The cost of a permit is £26.00 per annum for passenger vehicles and £21 annually for a motorcycle. Visitor tickets are also available. Schedule 2, 3 and 4 of The Borough Council of Chelmsford (Waiting, Loading and Parking Consolidation) Order 2009 will be amended to include the restrictions detailed above.
