

**THE ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL (EARLS COLNE) (40MPH SPEED LIMIT)  
ORDER 2004**

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1), (2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall drive any motor vehicle at a speed exceeding 40 miles per hour in that length of road at Earls Colne in the District of Braintree specified in the Schedule to this Order.
2. This Order shall come into operation on 31 March 2004 and may be cited as the Essex County Council ( Earls Colne) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 2004.
3. This order will revoke the Essex County Council (Station Road, Earls Colne) (40 mph Speed Limit) Order 1997.

## SCHEDULE

### Lengths of road at Earls Colne in the District of Braintree

| <u>Name of Road</u> | <u>Description</u>   |
|---------------------|--|
| Station Road        | from the junction with the A604 Halstead Road, in a north-westerly direction to a point 19 metres north west of the junction with De Vere Road, an approximate distance of 709 metres. |
| Curds Road          | from the junction with Coggeshall Road, north westerly and then north easterly for a total distance of 753 metres.   |
