

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Earls Colne) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 20**

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 84(1) and (2) and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order: To extend the existing 40MPH Speed limit on Station Road, Earls Colne, in the District of Braintree, from a point approximately 19 metres north west of its junction with the northern kerb line of De Vere Road, in a north westerly direction for a distance of approximately 77 metres (the road is currently national speed limit).

'The Essex County Council (Earls Colne) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2004' and 'The Essex County Council (B1024 Coggeshall Road, America Road, Curds Road and Station Road, Earls Colne) (40mph Speed Limit) Order 2014' are hereby revoked, the restriction contained within these order shall continue in force by virtue of this order.
