## Puffin Crossing – Middleton Hall Lane, Brentwood

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Part III & IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

**Effects of the order:** 1) To revoke 'No Stopping Mon-Friday 8AM-5PM on Entrance Markings' restrictions, on the following length of Middleton Hall Lane, in the Borough of Brentwood: BOTH SIDES: from a point approximately 44 metres south of its junction with Shenfield Road in a southerly direction, for a direction of approximately 71 metres. 2) To revoke 'No Waiting Mon-Sat 8AM-10PM and 3PM-6PM' Middleton Hall Lane, Brentwood, WEST SIDE: from a point approximately115 metres south of its junction with Shenfield Road, in a

Southerly direction for a distance of approximately 90 metres. 3) To implement

'No Waiting At Any Time' on Middleton Hall Lane, Brentwood, BOTH SIDES: from a point approximately 44 metres south of its junction with Shenfield Road in a southerly direction, for a distance of approximately 6 metres. EAST SIDE: from a point approximately 102 metres south of its junction with Shenfield Road in a southerly direction, for a distance of 13 metres. WEST SIDE: from a point approximately 102 metres south of its junction with Shenfield Road in a southerly direction, for a distance of 13 metres. WEST SIDE: from a point approximately 102 metres south of its junction with Shenfield Road in a southerly direction, for a distance of 25.5 metres. 4) To implement 'No Waiting Mon-Sat 8AM-10AM and 3PM-6PM Middleton Hall Lane, Brentwood WEST SIDE: from a point approximately 127.5 metres south of its junction with Shenfield Road, in a southerly direction for a distance of approximately 81.5 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Brentwood Borough) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting tile number TQ600 940 Revision 0 to Revision 1

**Notice is also hereby given that** under Sections 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the Essex County Council proposes to establish a Puffin Crossing on Middleton Hall Lane, in the Borough of Brentwood, the centre line of the proposed crossing will be located approximately 72 metres south its junction from Shenfield Road.

The crossing is approximately 6 metres wide between give way lines. It is proposed that, one set of eight zigzag markings measuring approximately 17 metres in length are installed on the northern side of the puffin crossing and one set of 14 zigzag markings measuring approximately 25 metres in length are installed on the southern side of the puffin crossing
