<u>Upgrade of Existing Un-controlled Crossing to a Humped (Raised Table)</u> <u>Parallel Crossing – Church Langley Way, Harlow</u>

Notice is hereby given that under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and Sections 90A and 90C of the Highways Act 1980, the Essex County Council proposes to establish a Parallel Crossing Upgrade within Church Langley Way, in the District of Harlow located as follows:

The above Parallel Crossing will be installed on a Raised Table with the following dimensions:

The Raised Table will have an upstand of approximately 75 millimetres and a length of approximately 19.2 metres. The gradient of the on/off ramps is proposed to be 8.3 %.

Zig-Zags for the above Parallel Crossing will be installed on Church Langley Way, Harlow in the following locations:

BOTH SIDES

- from the eastern give way line of the Parallel Crossing in an easterly direction for a distance of approximately 17.6 metres.
- from the western give way line of the Parallel Crossing in a westerly direction for a distance of approximately 17.6 metres

The Crossing will measure approximately 7 metres wide between give way lines.
