

**The Essex County Council (Fairfield Road, Manor Street, Market Place Service Road, Victoria Street, Braintree) (Experimental Waiting Restriction) Order 2020**

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Sections 9, 10 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III to Schedule 9 to the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. This Order shall come into operation on 18 September 2020 and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Fairfield Road, Manor Street, Market Place Service Road, Victoria Street, Braintree) (Experimental Waiting Restriction) Order 2020.
2. This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Braintree District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting tile number TL755 227, TL760 227, TL760 230 revision 0 to revision 1, TL755 230 revision 1 to revision 2.
3. This Order shall have an effect for a period of not exceeding 18 months from the date specified in Article 1 hereof or until it is made permanent.
4. Pursuant to Section 10(2) of the Act, the Interim Director of Highways may if it appears to him in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic, or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which the road affected by the Order runs, and after consultation with the Chief Office of Police, make modifications of any description (other than additions) to the Order or suspend the Order or any provision thereof.
