

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.14) Order **

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (4), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order:

1. To remove a section of 24hr Rural Clearway on the following length of London Road in the Town of Harlow in the District of Harlow:

LOCATION	EXTENT
London Road	BOTH SIDES: From a point approximately 12.1 metres north of the central reservation at the entrance/exit onto the Gilden Way Roundabout, north for approximately 135 metres

2. To Introduce a Red Route on the following lengths of Road in the Town of Harlow in the District of Harlow:

LOCATION	EXTENT
London Road	i. EAST SIDE: From a point approximately 12.1 metres north of the central reservation at the entrance/exit onto the Gilden Way Roundabout, north for approximately 135 metres ii. WEST SIDE: From a point approximately 12.1 metres north of the central reservation at the entrance/exit onto the Gilden Way Roundabout, north for approximately 118 metres
East Park	BOTH SIDES: From its junction with London Road, west for approximately 19.4 metres.
Access Road to Communal Garages	EAST SIDE: From its junction with East Park in a southerly direction for approximately 3 metres

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting tile numbers TL470 110 and TL470 112 revision 0 to revision 1.
