

**The Essex County Council (Various Roads (Mill Lane Development),
Cressing) (20mph Zone) Order 20****

The Essex County Council ("the Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84(1) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order:-

1. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to be driven at a speed exceeding 20 miles per hour on the said lengths of various roads in the Mill Lane Development, Cressing in the District of Braintree as specified in the Schedule to this order.
2. No speed restriction imposed by this Order applies to vehicles falling within regulation 3(4) of the Road Traffic Exemptions (Special Forces) (Variation and Amendment) Regulations 2011 when used in accordance with regulation 3(5) of those Regulations.
3. This Order shall come into operation on ***** 20** and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Various Roads (Mill Lane Development), Cressing) (20mph Zone) Order 20**.

Schedule: 20mph Zone

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| Crozier Drive | From a point approximately 5 metres north east of its junction with Mill lane, north east the south east, then north for a distance of approximately 312 metres |
| Sutton Park | For its entire length, south west for a distance of approximately 81 metres |
| Moss End | For its entire length, south east, then north and south, for a distance of approximately 93 metres |
| Howlett Place | For its entire length, south east, for a distance of approximately 51 metres |
| Halls Grove | For its entire length, south east, then north-east and south-west, for a distance of approximately 145 metres |
