To Implement – No Stopping on School Keep Clear Markings Mon-Fri 8am-4.00pm on Tendring Road in the District of Harlow, north side, from a point approximately 120 metres east of the eastern kerb line of Barn Mead (the eastern end of the existing 'School Keep Clear, restriction), east of existing restrictions for a distance of approximately 37 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Harlow District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting tiles TL450 087, TL445 087 revision 0 to revision 1.
