

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (Rochford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.12) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given that** the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

### Effect of the order:

1. **TO IMPLEMENT:** 'No Waiting at Any time' restrictions on the following length of road, in the District of Rochford as specified:

Road	Description
Rochford Garden Way, Rochford (north arm of junction)	BOTH SIDES: From a point approximately 10 metres north of Percy Cottis Road for approximately 12 metres in a northly direction.
Rochford Garden Way, Rochford (east arm of junction)	NORTH SIDE: From a point approximately 10 metres north of Percy Cottis Road for approximately 10 metres in an easterly direction.
Rochford Garden Way, Rochford (west arm of junction)	NORTH SIDE: From a point approximately 10 metres north of Percy Cottis Road for approximately 10 metres in a Westerly direction.

This Order will be incorporated into 'The Essex County Council (Rochford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019' by substituting map tiles: TQ870 912 Revision 3 to Revision 4.
