

# Public notice

## The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Kirby Cross) (20mph Zone) Order 202\*

**Notice is hereby given** that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under sections 84(1) and (2), and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

**Effect of the order: To Implement:** a '20mph Zone' – Kirby Cross, in the District of Tendring

Road	Description
Barley Road	From a point approximately 14 metres from its junction with Halstead Road, southwards then eastwards, for its remaining length, including any turning heads.
Farro Drive	From its junction with Wheatsheaf, for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Grain Drive	From its junction with Barley Road, for its entire length.
Millet Road	From its junction with Barley Road, for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Outside	From its junction with Barley Road, for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Poppy Way	From its junction with Barley Road, for its entire length.
Rye Way	From its junction with Wheatsheaf, for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Spelt Road	From its junction with Barley Road, for its entire length.
Sunflower Lane	From its junction with Wheatsheaf, for its entire length, including any turning heads.
Wheatsheaf	From its junction with Barley Road, for its entire length, including any turning heads.
