

**The Essex County Council (City of Colchester) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No. 52)
Order 202***

STATEMENT OF REASONS:

The permanent order for the enhancement of double yellow lines is required to prevent obstructive carriageway and footway parking. The installation of sections of single yellow lines with time restrictions, is required to prevent vehicles being left for long periods of time, to allow for visitor parking and customers for the local businesses.

Although it is a cul-de-sac, the road provides connectivity to surrounding residential properties, University of Essex student accommodation, various small business and until recently a B&Q site which is currently being developed.

Lightship Way is considered to be an important pedestrian route through to the main university campus via a pedestrian bridge over the Clacton-Colchester railway line. These restrictions will improve pedestrian safety as they will prevent the obstructive parking on footway.

Restrictions will prevent obstructions to larger vehicles including buses, promote free flow of traffic for all road users and enhance the line of sight & safety for all motorists and pedestrians.
