

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.45) Order 202*.

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the order below under S1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53, 84(1) (a) and (2) and Parts IV and III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

1. To Revoke: 'No Waiting & Loading Mon-Fri 8.30am-9.30am and 2.30pm-3.30pm' Restrictions.

Road	Description
School Road, Elmstead	East Side From a point approximately 18 metres North of its junction with Pine Way, South for approximately 38 metres.

2. To Implement: 'No Waiting & Loading Mon-Fri 8.30am - 9.30am and 2.30pm - 3.30pm' Restrictions.

Road	Description
Pine Way, Elmstead	Both Sides: From a point approximately 10 metres from its junction with School Road eastwards for approximately 47 metres.

3. To Implement: 'No Waiting at Any Time' Restrictions in Elmstead.

Road	Description
Pine Way	Both Sides: From its junction with School Road East for approximately 10 metres.
School Road	North East Side: From the northern extended kerb line of Pine Way, North for approximately 16 metres. South East Side: From the southern extended kerb line of Pine Way, South for approximately 16 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Tendring District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting map tiles:
