

The Essex County Council (A120, Stansted) (Prohibition of U-Turns) Order 202*.

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 (1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. No person shall except under the direction of a Police Constable in uniform cause any vehicle to proceed in that length of The Essex County Council (A120, Stansted) (Prohibition of U-Turns) Order 202* in the Schedule to this Order in a direction other than that specified in Column 2 of said Schedule.
2. Nothing in the Schedule of this Order shall apply if the vehicle is being used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance purposes.
3. This Order come into operation on ** ***** 202* and may be cited as The Essex County Council (A120, Stansted) (Prohibition of U-Turns) Order 202*.

The Effect of the Order:

1. **To Implement:** A Prohibition of 'U-Turn' restriction on the following lengths of road

Road	Description
A120 Eastbound:	At its signalised junction with A1250 Dunmow Road so as to prohibit transfer to the westbound carriageway.
A120 Westbound:	At its signalised junction with Birchanger Lane so as to prohibit its transfer to the eastbound carriageway.
