

**The Essex County Council (Little Waltham Byway 51, City of Chelmsford)
(Prohibition of Use to All, Including Vehicles, Equestrians & Pedestrians) Order
202*.**

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 (1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. No person shall except under the direction of a Police Constable in uniform cause any vehicle to proceed in the length of Little Waltham Byway 51, City of Chelmsford, from its junction with Footpath 40, for approximately 120 metres to its junction with Footpath 42 Little Waltham (hereinafter referred to as the said length of byway). This restriction will be located as indicated on the plan attached to this order.
2. Nothing in the Schedule of this Order shall apply if the vehicle is being used for Fire and Rescue, Police or Ambulance purposes.
3. This Order come into operation on ** ***** 202* and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Little Waltham Byway 51, City of Chelmsford) (Prohibition of Use) Order 202*.
