

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Castle Point District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.17) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

Effect of the Order:

1. To Revoke: 'Disabled Badge Holders Only'

Road	Description
Sycamore Close Canvey	North side: From a point approximately 6 metres west of the shared boundary of 13 and 15 Sycamore Close, eastwards for approximately 6.5 metres, width approximately 2 metres.
North Avenue Canvey	East side: From a point approximately 0.5 metres west of the western boundary line of 50 North Avenue, eastwards for approximately 4 metres.

2. To Upgrade: (from Advisory to Enforceable) 'Disabled Badge Holders Only'

Road	Description
Broomfield Green Canvey	North West Side: From a point approximately 2 metres south east of the boundary line of 28 and 30 Broomfield Green, south eastwards for approximately 5.0 metres, width approximately 2.5 metres.
Hilton Road Canvey	East side: From a point in line with the shared boundary of 172 and 174 Hilton Road, northwards for approximately 5.5 metres.

3. To Introduce: 'Disabled Badge Holders Only'

Road	Description
Cedar Road Canvey	North West side: From a point in line with the shared boundary of 36 and 38 Cedar Road, north eastwards for approximately 5 metres.
