

**The Essex County Council (Footpath No.64, City of Chelmsford) (Prohibition of Cycling) Order 202\*.**

The Essex County Council (hereinafter referred to as "The Council") in exercise of its powers under Section 84 (1) (a) and (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (hereinafter referred to as "The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 of the Act, hereby make the following Order: -

1. No person shall except under the direction of a Police Constable in uniform cause any cyclists to proceed in the length of Footpath No.64, City of Chelmsford as detailed in the schedule to this order.
2. This Order will come into operation on \*\* \*\*\*\*\* 202\* and may be cited as The Essex County Council (Footpath No.64, City of Chelmsford) (Prohibition of Cycling) Order 202\*.

**1. To Implement: A 'Prohibition of Cycling' Restriction on The Following Footpath**

Footpath 64, Fortinbras Way	From its junction with Fortinbras Way, North West for approximately 67 metres to its junction with Moulsham Drive.
