

Public notice

The Essex County Council (A133 Clacton Road, A133 Colchester Road, Tye Road, A1331 Link Road, Elmstead) (50mph Speed Limit) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Orders under Sections 84(1)(a) and (2) and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

The Effect of the Order:

1. To Implement: '50mph Speed Limit' (currently National Speed Limit - Dual Carriage Way 70mph)

Road	Description
A133 Clacton Road (Eastbound)	From a point approximately 77 metres west of the centre of Loverose Lane east for approximately 535 metres
A133 Colchester Road (Westbound)	From a point approximately 199 metres west of the centre of Elmstead Road west for approximately 597 metres

2. To Implement: '50mph Speed Limit' (currently National Speed Limit 60mph)

Road	Description
Tye Road	From its junction with the A1331 Link Road north west for approximately 60 metres

3. To Introduce: '50mph Speed Limit' (New Build)

Road	Description
A1331 Link Road	From its junction with A133 Clacton Road for its entire length, approximately 1745 metres (ending at and inclusive of Allens Farm Roundabout)
