

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Dunmow, and Little Dunmow) (Combined Speed Limits) Order 202*

The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) (Amendment No.38) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order under Sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1), 4(2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49, 53 and Parts III and IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended).

The Effect of the Order:

1. To Implement: a '30mph Speed Limit' (currently 40mph)

Road	Direction
(B1256) Stortford Road	From a point approximately 3 metres west of its junction with the Blackwater Drive roundabout east (for approximately 632 metres) to a point approximately 36 metres east of Woodlands Roundabout (including the circulatory carriageway of Blackwater Drive Roundabout).
Blackwater Drive	From its junction with the roundabout at (B1256) Stortford Road and Blackwater Drive north for approximately 15 metres
Pincey Brook Drive	From its junction with (B1256) Stortford Road north for approximately 12 metres

2. To Implement: a '40mph Speed Limit' (currently 50mph)

Road	Direction
Woodside Way	From a point approximately 20 metres north of Woodlands Roundabout north for approximately 300 metres.
Blackwater Drive	From its junction with Woodside Way west for approximately 12 metres
Woodlands Park Drive	From its junction with Pines Roundabout east for approximately 5 metres

3. To Implement: a '40mph Speed Limit' (currently National Speed Limit)

Road	Direction
(B1256) Stortford Road	From its junction with Dunmow West Interchange Roundabout east for approximately 219 metres (to existing)

The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Dunmow, and Little Dunmow) (Combined Speed Limits) Order (No.2) 2025 is hereby revoked in its entirety. All restrictions not shown above shall remain in force by virtue of this new Order.

4. To Revoke: 'No waiting at any time'

Road	Direction
(B1256) Stortford Road	From a point approximately 33 metres west of the Woodlands Roundabout east for a distance of approximately 185 metres to a point approximately 95 metres east of the roundabout - to include the circulatory carriageway of Woodside Way Roundabout
Woodside Way	From its junction with Woodlands Roundabout north for approximately 20 metres



5. To Implement: 24hr Clearway (No Stopping on Main Carriageway, Verge or footway)

Road	Direction
(B1256) Stortford Road	Both Sides of Carriageway: From a point approximately 95 metres east of the Woodlands Roundabout circulatory carriageway, west for approximately 1016 metres. to include the circulatory carriageway of Woodside Way Roundabout
Woodside Way	Both Sides of Carriageway: From its junction with Woodlands Roundabout circulatory carriageway, north for approximately 20 metres.
Pincey Brook Drive	Both Sides of Carriageway: From its junction with (B1256) Stortford Road north for approximately 16 metres.
Blackwater Drive	Both Sides of Carriageway: From its junction with (B1256) Stortford Road north for approximately 15 metres.
Kestrel Gardens	Both Sides of Carriageway: From its junction with (B1256) Stortford Road north for approximately 15 metres.
Butleys Lane	Both Sides of Carriageway: From its junction with (B1256) Stortford Road north for approximately 15 metres.

This Order will be incorporated into The Essex County Council (Uttlesford District) (Prohibition of Waiting, Loading and Stopping) and (On-Street Parking Places) (Civil Enforcement Area) Consolidation Order 2019 by substituting map tiles: Introducing TL605 215 and TL610 215 Revision 0, TL610 217 Revision 0 to Revision 1 TL615 217 Revision 0 to Revision 1
