Notice is hereby given that under Section 23 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) the Essex County Council proposes to upgrade of an existing Zebra Crossing, to a Signalised (Puffin) Pedestrian Crossing on Ferrers Road, South Woodham Ferrers in the City of Chelmsford.

Effect of the Proposal: To Upgrade: an existing Zebra Crossing to a signalised Puffin Crossing

Location of the crossing centre line	From a point approximately 54 metres east of the centre line of Benbow Drive
Width between stop lines:	Approximately 6 metres
Length of zigzags	Approximately 17 metres either side of the crossing.
