The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Dunmow, and Little Dunmow) (Combined Speed Limits) (Amendment 1) Order 202*

Notice is hereby given that Essex County Council proposes to make the above Order Amendment under Sections 84(1)(a) and (2) and Part III of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended)

The Effect of the Order:

To Implement: a '40mph Speed Limit' (currently 50mph)

Road	Direction
Woodside Way	From a point approximately 25 metres north of the centre of Black Water Drive, northeast for approximately 275 metres.
Woodlands Park Drive (North)	From its Junction with Woodside Way southeast for approximately 26 metres

The Essex County Council proposes to amend 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Dunmow, and Little Dunmow) (Combined Speed Limits) Order 2026, varying the speed limit restriction on Woodside Way and introducing a speed limit restriction on Woodlands Park Drive, all other restrictions of 'The Essex County Council (Various Roads, Great Dunmow, and Little Dunmow) (Combined Speed Limits) Order 2026 shall remain unchanged and continuing in force by this order.
