4	Matters arising from minutes of previous meeting There were none.	Chair
5	Public Questions Two residents from Flag Hill, near Great Bentley, attended to raise concerns about safety and speed issues along the B1027. Both residents had attended their local parish councils, St Osyth and Great Bentley, and had their support in pursuing the issues. Officers advised they would review the road and also share the results with local parish councils so that local residents could feed into any actions as a result of the review. The issue would be brought back to the panel in the summer.	
6	Casualty Reduction 2020/21 Ian Henderson presented three Casualty Reduction Sites and outlined the potential measures that could be taken:  • B1414 Oak Cottage Corner jw Wix Road; Intervention works: Site visit identified:	



- Advanced give way sign obscured by existing tree
- Road markings worn
- · Poor conspicuity of Give Way sign
- · Flag type direction signs missing

Improve give way signage, increase conspicuity of Give Way Sign and relocate advanced give way sign) with yellow backing boards, re-apply junction markings, replace flag type direction signs, and vegetation removal.

Consider advisory speed limit signs and bend ahead warning signing on the NB approach

Principle: A study of personal injury collisions at this location indicates a pattern of southbound road users from Wix Road turning right on to B1414 Harwich Road in to the path of oncoming vehicles.

#### A133 Main Road jw B1029 Bromley Road;

Intervention works: Proposal to carry out a feasibility study to change the traffic signals timings to allow separate northbound and southbound green phases.

Anecdotal evidence indicates this is a busy junction, particularly during peak times, so road users gap acceptance may be reduced.

Principle: A study of personal injury collisions at this location indicates a pattern of northbound road users turning right across the path of southbound road users at the signalised junction. None of the collisions involved road users disobeying a red signal on the junction. An additional collision in September 2019 of similar nature has been recorded.

#### A133 Clacton Road approx. 1.5km south east of Elmstead Market

Intervention works: It was noted during the site visit:

- · Wide single carriageway with centre hatching.
- Double bend with first southbound radius greater than would be considered for provision of chevron signs.
- Existing verge markers in poor condition.

Upgrade existing bend warning signs with yellow backing boards. Consider additional advisory speed limit plate, vegetation clearance, verge marker posts. It may be appropriate to carry out the proposals during, or as part of, the programmed resurfacing works to minimise disruption.

Principle: A study of personal injury collisions at this location indicates a pattern of loss of control collisions on a wet/damp carriageway surface. Two collisions were travelling north west to south east, two collisions were travelling south east to north west. However, one of the south east to north west collisions was due to an oncoming vehicle crossing in to opposing lane.



#### 7 Report on Funded Schemes 2019/20

The report provided an update on the current position of all the schemes which the Tendring Local Highway Panel had recommended for inclusion in the 2019/20 programme.

Members were reminded that the costs supplied were budget allocations only and there was the possibility that a final scheme cost could change dependant on issues which may arise especially during detailed design and construction. There was a remaining budget of £6,000 which needed to be allocated to direct delivery designs for 2019-20.

Cllr Goggin proposed that the oldest schemes were to be added first to last. Cllr Belgrove seconded the proposal and Members agreed.

Cllr Henderson reminded officers of the need to have schemes LTEN162033 - Williamsburg Avenue, Harwich, and LTEN172010 - Wellington Road jw Church Street, Harwich, completed as a priority so as not to impact on the forthcoming Mayflower400 events.

Cllr Guglielmi highlighted to the Panel work that had been aligned with S278 meaning that schemes had been able to be cancelled thereby saving funding, and thanked officers for enabling this.

#### 8 Report on Schemes Awaiting Funding

The Schemes Awaiting Funding list (previously The Potential Schemes List) identified all the scheme requests which had been received for the consideration of the Tendring District Local Highways Panel.

Members were asked to review those schemes and consider removing any they would not wish to consider for future funding.

The breakdown of scheme types available for future consideration was as follows:

Costs supplied were estimates only and there was the possibility that a final scheme cost could change significantly dependant on issues which may arise during detailed design and construction.

LTEN165050 - Cox's Hill, Lawford - Cllr Guglielmi agreed to keep the scheme on the Schemes Awaiting Funding list until October. Cllr Guglielmi requested Officers draft a letter to Cllr Bentley from Panel to request an explanation of which criteria is used when negotiating with developers.

The following items were agreed for inclusion to the Funded Schemes List:

- LTEN182030 Weeley Heath, Gateway Signage
- LTEN182031 Tendring Road, Thorpe-le-Soken
- LTEN162009 Various locations around Manningtree

Cllr Erskine agreed to raise LTEN182027 - Sladburys Lane, Clacton-on-Sea, at a surgery with Cllr Bentley.

It was agreed that Essex Highways Road Safety Education Officers would prioritise the remaining 20's Plenty Schemes.

It was agreed that Officers would draft a letter to Cllr Bentley and Highways England advising of the damage caused as a result of A120 diversions, such as collapsed drains, due to a lack of signage warning HGV's not to use certain roads, and also the removal of leftover signage.

It was agreed that the five pedestrian crossing schemes across the district should proceed.

LTEN173001 - Long Road, Lawford - Zebra Crossing

LTEN173006 - Cloes Lane, Clacton-on-Sea - Zebra Crossing

LTEN173007 - Parkeston Road, Harwich - Zebra Crossing

LTEN163007 - Valley Road, Clacton-on-Sea - Zebra Crossing

LTEN162007 - Marine Parade East, Clacton-on-Sea - Zebra Crossing

Officers then advised that providing the Panel would agree to the scheme in principle, discussions could take place with the contractor for scheme LTEN162007 – Marine Parade East, Clacton-on-Sea. This would allow the contractor to prepare for construction at the beginning of the 2020/21 financial year. The Panel agreed with this proposal.

It was agreed to keep LTEN163009 - Grange Road, Lawford, on the Schemes Awaiting Funding list.

It was agreed to select option A on scheme LTEN193001 - A133 Main Road, Frating.
