

Public notice

The Essex County Council (Byway 37 & 75, Debden and Byway 34, Widdington) (Temporary Prohibition of Motor Vehicles & Horse Drawn Vehicles) Order 2020

Notice is hereby given that the Essex County Council intends, not less than seven days from the date of this notice, to make the above Order under section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

Effect of the order: To temporarily prohibit motor vehicles & horse drawn vehicles from using the following extents of Byway 37 & 75, Debden and Byway 34, Widdington in the District of Uttlesford:

Byway	Description
Byway 37, Debden (Sampsons Lane)	For its entire length, commencing from its junction with Rook End Lane at grid reference TL 5567 3254, south east to its junction with the unclassified road at Mathews Farm at grid reference TL 5673 3091. Total distance approximately 2.45 kilometres.
Byway 34, Widdington	For its entire length, commencing from its junction with Widdington Bridleway 33 at the parish boundary with Debden at grid reference TL 5592 3190, north east then south to the point where it meets the parish boundary with Debden at grid reference TL 5607 3153. Total distance approximately 575 metres.
Byway 75, Debden (Green Croft Lane)	From its junction with the unclassified road at Mathews Farm at grid reference TL 5672 3090, west to its junction with the unclassified road at Amberden Hall at grid reference TL 5569 3081. Total distance approximately 1.1 kilometres.

The prohibition of motor vehicles & horse drawn vehicles is scheduled to commence on 01/11/2020 to 30/04/2021 or where appropriate signs are showing and weather permitting. The restriction is required for the safety of the public and to prevent further damage to the byway surface.

The alternative route for motor vehicles & horse drawn vehicles will be as follows:
For Debden Byway 37: Rook End Lane, Thaxted Road, Bolford Street, Henham Road, unnamed road between Henham Road and Sampsons Lane.
For Debden Byway 75: Unnamed road between Green Croft Lane and Henham Road, Chickney Road, Hall Road, Old Mead Road, North Hall Road, Hollow Road, High Street, Cornells Lane.

Access for emergency service vehicles, pedal cycles, horse riders and pedestrians will be maintained at all times during the works. Access will also be permitted to properties on or adjacent to the Byway.

The Order will come into effect on 01/11/2020 and may continue in force for 6 months.
