

Army and Navy flyover removal works start 10 February 2020



Works start 10 February 2020 to remove the Army and Navy flyover. Much of the work will be carried out overnight between the hours of 9.30pm and 5.30am, Monday to Friday, until the works complete in April 2020. Some daytime working will be required, including two Sundays during March.

Overnight lane restrictions will be needed to support the works reducing the carriageway to one lane on the roundabout and approaches/exits. Some road closures will also be needed overnight depending on the activity being carried out. Diversions will be in place during planned closures.

Pedestrian access through the area will be maintained during the works.
