Latest progress – Sept 2019

Edinburgh Way – Road box Construction – Harlow Mill Roundabout – North Place

We have now placed the first layer of surfacing to this area. This will allow us to move the traffic to the north side of Edinburgh Way providing space for the southern side to be constructed. In the future we will place the final surfacing course to the road. We have also completed all of the footpath construction through this area ready for footpath surfacing to be completed. We have installed the traffic signal ducts for the future traffic lights and raised all of the existing service covers to the finished footpath level.

Latest progress – Sept 2019

Edinburgh Way - Road box Construction - North Place – River Way Roundabout

We have now completed all of the road box excavation through this section along with the placement of the road foundation and kerbs. We have completed 80% of the footpath construction through this area along with the traffic signal ducts and the raising of the service covers and lids to the finished levels.

Edinburgh Way – Drainage

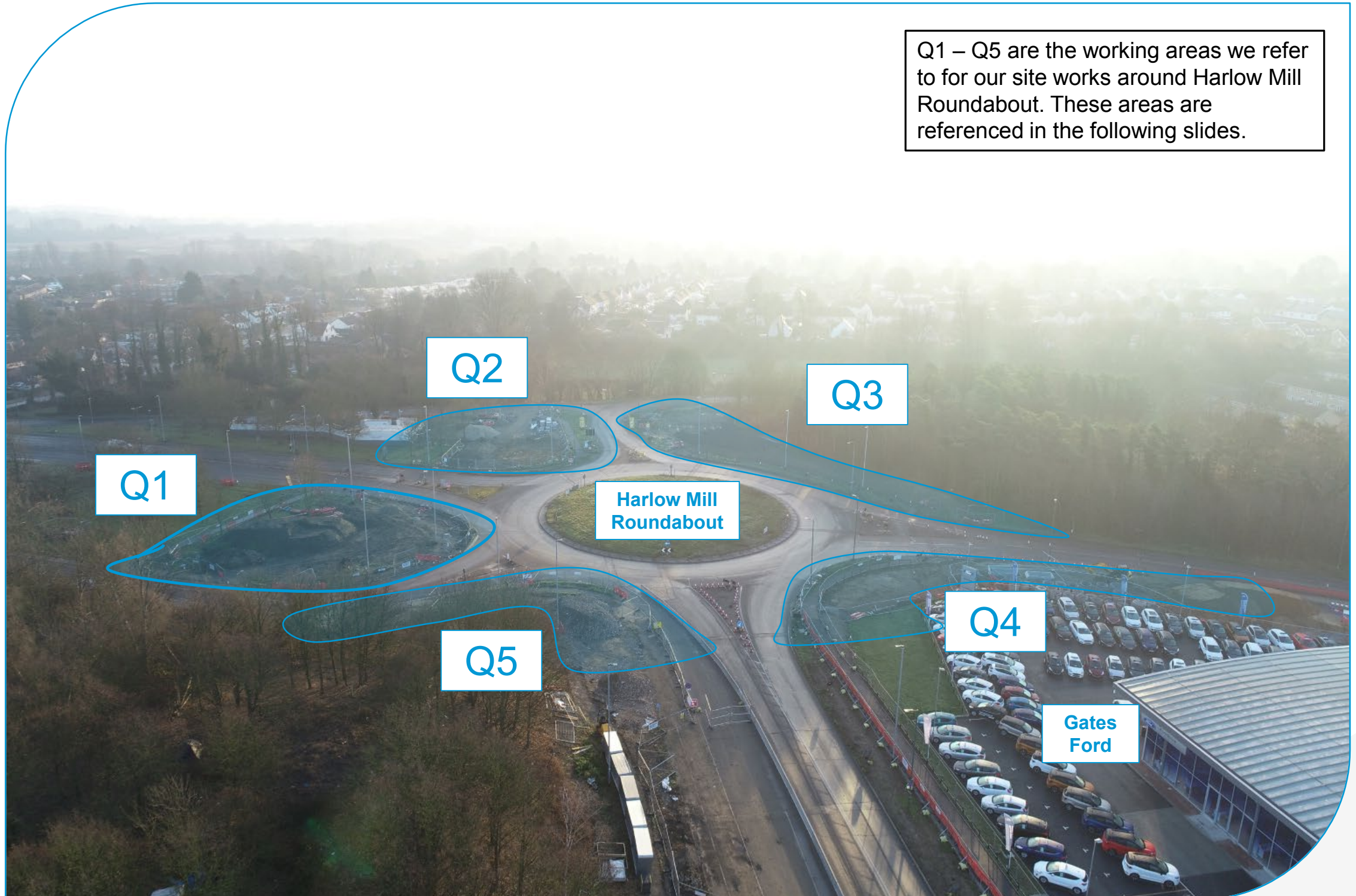
We have completed the final section of drainage to the north side of the scheme

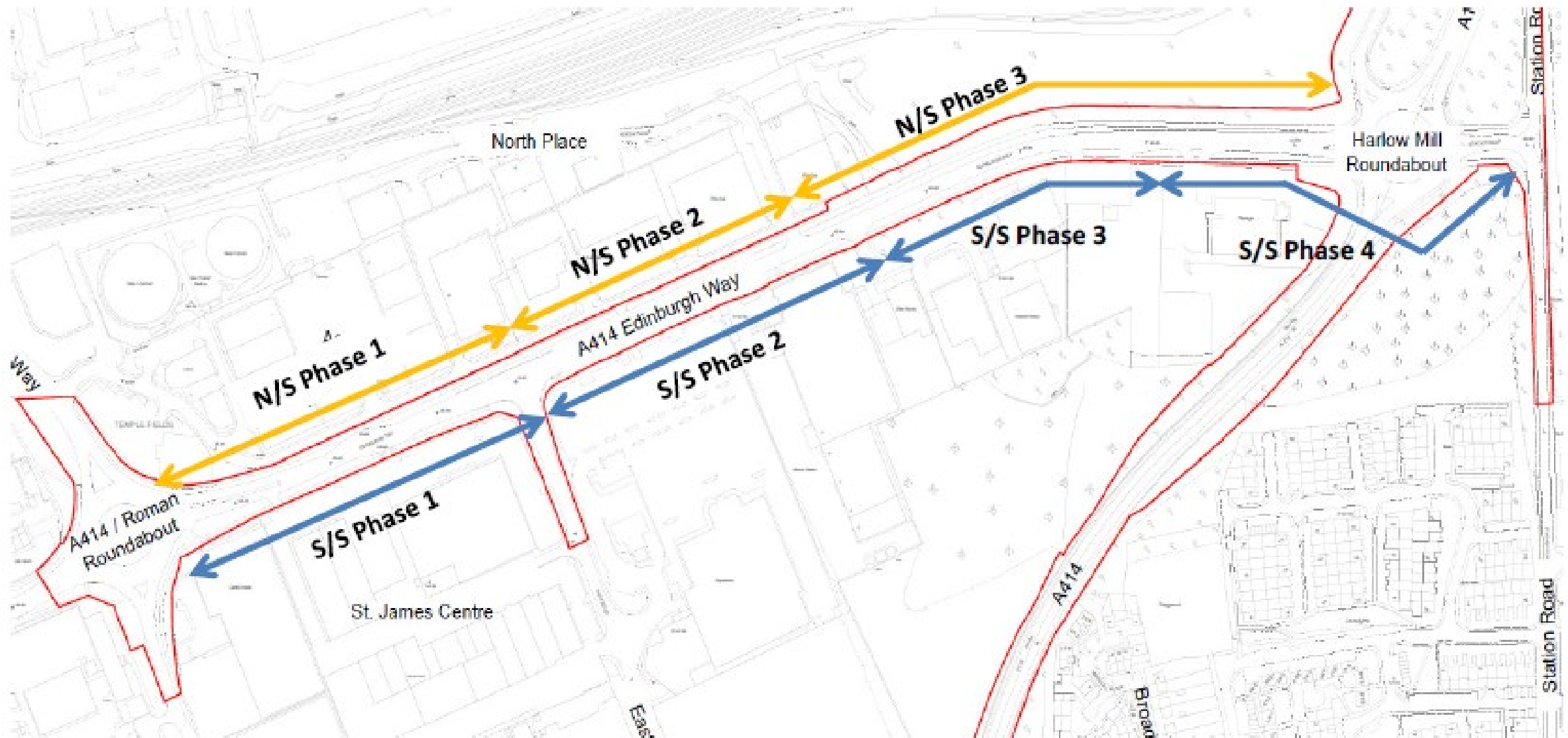
