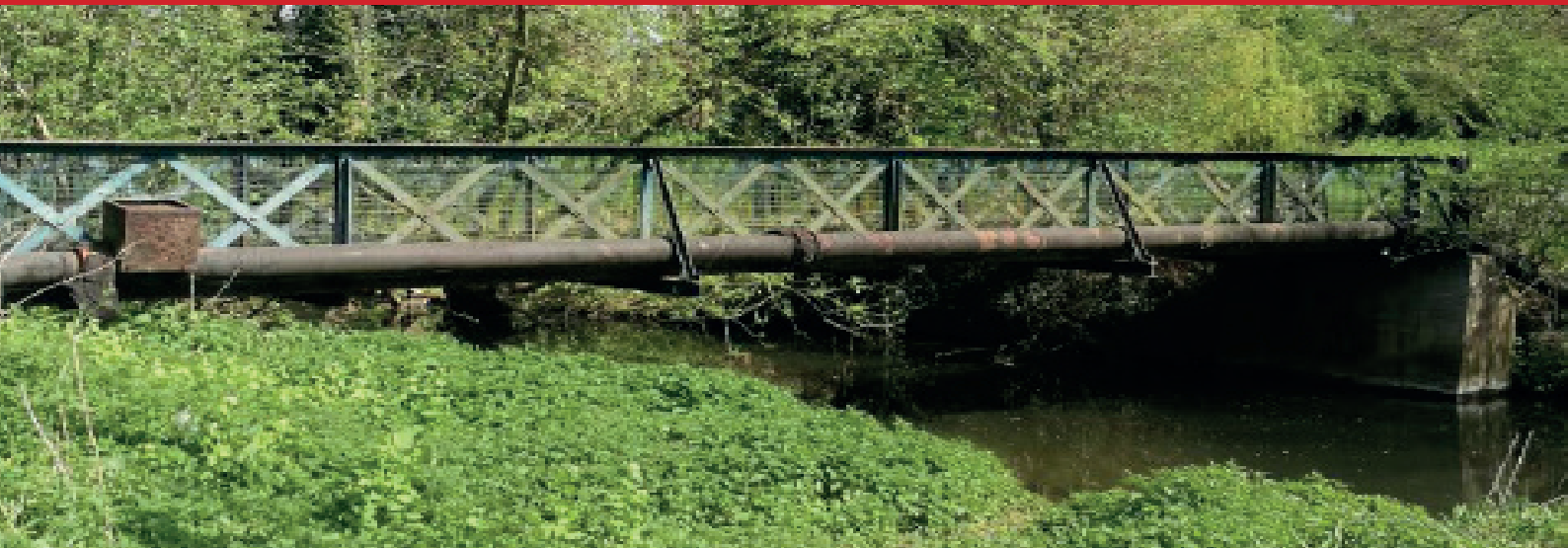


Admirals Bridge replacement works - Admirals Park, Chelmsford



Admirals Bridge located in Admirals Park, Chelmsford is due to be replaced with a wider, four metre shared use structure for pedestrians and cyclists. This work will take place from 1 June 2020 as one of the improvement schemes being implemented by Essex County Council as part of the Chelmsford City Growth Package.

Works are expected to take approximately three months to complete.

To support pedestrians and cyclists during this period a temporary bridge and footpath will be installed to provide ongoing access during the works. Please note that there will be occasions when the temporary bridge and footpath will be closed for short periods to protect the public from large vehicle movements and the installation of the new bridge.
