

Oasis Bridge refurbishment, Springfield Road/ Chelmer Road, Chelmsford



Arrangements have been made to refurbish this four span bridge and install new vehicle safety barriers known as a vehicle restraint system (VRS) as well as inspection platforms to support future surveys.

Works are proposed to begin **Monday 19 April 2021** and are programmed to be completed in approximately eight months, subject to weather permitting and no unexpected issues arising.

Throughout the various phases of the works, traffic management will be adjusted to ensure the safety of the public and workforce is maintained. We anticipate this will include the following:

- Single carriageway closures on B1137 Springfield Road to maintained traffic flows in both directions
- A temporary contra-flow will be used to maintain the traffic flow over the bridge on the A138 Chelmer Road during certain aspect of the works
- Night time road closures over the bridge will be required for jacking and de-jacking of the bridge, required during bearing replacement works
- Night time closure of the A138 to install the contra flow traffic management and reinstatement of white lining and road studs
