I am pleased to inform you that footway repair work will be going ahead at the location and times stated on the front of this leaflet.

If you have any particular access requirements or requests, please speak to the Supervisor on site so they can accommodate your request when programming the particular activity.

Where applicable please could you ensure any vegetation is cut back to your boundary line to enable access to the full width of the footway. Should this not take place, our contractors may be required to cut back the vegetation, to complete their work.

You will appreciate that work of this nature will create some noise and disruption. All efforts will be made to keep noise and disruption to a minimum and this will be monitored.

Thank you for your understanding and patience while this work is being carried out.

If you have any concerns or queries during delivery of this work, please contact the Supervisor on site in the first instance or contact our customer team using the details on this leaflet.

To avoid costly disruption to our work, we need to have the road clear so please don't park your car on the road when we put up the no parking signs.

Please note: if you do accidentally leave your car where we need to work, we will try to contact you, but if we can't find you we will issue a Penalty Charge Notice and remove your car to a local safe place.

If you can't find your car nearby after the work is completed, please call 0345 603 7631. Should you leave your vehicle in the works area, the following will apply:

Disclaimer Notice: Vehicles and their contents are left entirely at the owner's risk.



If you drive back to your property while we are working on the road nearby, we may have to ask you to park elsewhere - please park in a safe place and speak to one of our staff who will help you.

Access for emergency service vehicles and pedestrians will be maintained at all times. We will usually control traffic with temporary traffic lights or Stop/Go boards. If we need to close the road (depending on how wide it is), we will divert the traffic.

We will usually have staff at each end of where the road is closed. While work is in progress we will put up warning signs and we ask drivers to go very slowly and very carefully across the unfinished areas.

Please take extra care walking on to your property as there may be a higher step up. If we have to replace kerbs across your driveway you may not be able to drive in and out of your property for one night as material has to set.

If your property is affected, you will be notified by one of the works team. Pedestrian access to your property will always be maintained.
