We're changing the way you register for your parking and pay for your bus ticket.

From 1 April you will need to use a new mobile ticketing system called MiPermit, which will replace ParkJockey, and from 1 May ticket machines and the Automatic Number Plate Recognition system for the car park.

## When will this happen?

- **1 April** MiPermit is launched, you will not be able to use Park Jockey from this date. You will be able to continue to use the ticket machines until 1 May.
- 1 May

  Ticket machines and the Automatic
  Number Plate Recognition system will
  be removed, and you will need to use
  the MiPermit app on your smartphone
  to register for your parking and pay
  for your bus ticket. If you don't have a
  smartphone, please go to the reception
  area inside the building to register your
  vehicle. You will need to purchase a ticket
  when boarding the bus.

## Why is it changing?

The MiPermit app is simple and easy to use and will improve your experience of the Park & Ride. We're also aware that a number of people have started to use the Park & Ride car park without taking the bus. This new system will enable the car park to be patrolled and enforced if necessary. It also provides efficiencies for the site in the long term and as MiPermit is already used in many car parks (and for residential permits) across Essex, it supports a standardised offer in the area.
