

## **ESSEX COUNTY COUNCIL**

### **PROPOSED CONVERSION OF FOOTPATHS INTO CYCLE TRACKS IN BROOMFIELD**

**NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN** that Essex County Council has made an order to convert the entire length of Footpath 36 and part lengths of Footpaths 10 and 12 at Broomfield into designated cycle tracks including a right of way for pedestrians. These conversions are carried out under Section 3 of the Cycle Tracks Act 1984. The order will require confirmation before the conversion works can take place.

Where a copy of the drawing numbered: B3553A02-A-00-011 Rev B (“the plan”) is to accompany this notice, the plan indicates the proposed Cycle Tracks by solid red lines.

The lengths of the footpaths to be converted under the order may be described as follows:

#### **FOOTPATH 36**

The entire length of Footpath 36 consisting of a 1.5 metre wide path running from Point C on the Order Plan and running in a northerly direction for a total distance of approximately 65 metres to Point D where it the route terminates.

#### **FOOTPATH 10**

Part length of Footpath 10 consisting of a 1.5 metres wide path running in an north north easterly direction from Point B for a distance of approximately 192 metres where it connects and continues as the aforementioned Point C.

#### **FOOTPATH 12**

Part length of Footpath 12 consisting of a 1.5 metre wide path running from Point A on the Order Plan and running in a north north westerly direction for a total distance of approximately 112 metres to Point B where it connects to Footpath 10.

**FURTHER DETAILS:** The plan showing the Footpaths to be converted can be found on site or on deposit at Chelmsford Library County Hall Market Road Chelmsford CM1 1QH where the notice and the plan may be inspected free of charge during normal business opening hours.

A statement of reasons, the Order and a copy of the plan showing the routes to be annexed to the Order may be examined during normal office hours, free of charge, at Chelmsford Library County Hall Market Road Chelmsford CM1 1QH and Chelmsford City Council Civic Centre Duke Street Chelmsford Essex CM1 1JE.
